Responsibilities

- Collaborate with school staff to assess, identify and prioritize student needs
- Provide overall case management to identified students and deliver evidence-based interventions and supports, based on student and school needs
- Regularly and systematically collect, enter and report student data
- Connect with parent or legal guardian of identified case managed students
- Provide timely reports with data and program information to direct supervisor
- Provide leadership, as requested, in securing community resources and partners beneficial in improving students' physical and academic needs
- Guide at-risk youth participants through a Behavior Intervention and Management Analysis;
- Assist with recommendations for current in-house programs;
- Complete referrals for further assessments, and behavioral or mental health services;
- Provide and or assist with Case Management
- Assist with one-on-one and group sessions that actively promote healthy lifestyle choices as well as optimal emotional, social, and mental health.

Qualifications

- Degree or enrollment in Psychology, Social Work, Therapy, or Counseling degree program;
- Experience leading group facilitation
- Good organizational and follow up skills;
- Ability to work well with minimum supervision;
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to work with diverse community groups, and
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
